Dear friends,

Shalom from South Florida. I thank you so much for your faithful prayer and support, and for your friendship in this ministry of reaching Jewish people for the Messiah Yeshua. It really makes a difference.

Last month, I shared with you short accounts of the blessings that we had in our ministry in the previous year. Now, I am humbly asking you to pray for the fulfillment of some plans and visions that I have for the year 2007, along with our branch of Chosen People Ministries here in South Florida.

First and foremost, please pray for the future of Chosen People Ministries' Messianic Center of South Florida. We are blessed to be very close to securing a facility in Boca Raton. Please pray that God, by Himself despite all obstacles (financial and otherwise), will open doors and soften the hearts of all the people who are involved in this process. To have such a center will expand our ministry here in South Florida tremendously. Under the umbrella of this center – in the midst of a Jewish population of over one million – there will be a place for a congregation to worship (or several different congregations). We will also be able to use the center for an evangelistic café and social club, a Judaica store, a cultural evangelistic center (with different programs including Bible studies), a place for one to one conversation and small group Bible study, a place to store and distribute audio, video and written evangelistic materials, a base for our short-term evangelistic program "Fun in the Son" and much, much more.

I also ask that you pray about a new weekly Bible study that we want to start among English speaking people (Jews and Gentiles) in North Miami; it will be big challenge for me, personally.

A large portion of my time, as usual, is dedicated to personal discipleship. It is always good to see people rededicate, refocus their lives toward God. For instance, last Hanukkah as we celebrated the Feast of Dedication in our Russian speaking Messianic congregation, Yeshua touched the hearts of a few of the people who came to visit us and they rededicated their lives to Him during the service.
